AGENDA ITEMS:

1. A motion was made by Commissioner Jenkins and seconded by Commissioner Hall to **not** approve a request by Dale Nichols to open a Section Line between the following located in District #2:
The East 16.5 feet of Section 29, and the West 16.5 feet of Section 28, Township 18 North, Range 20 East, in Cherokee County, OK
The majority of the surrounding land owners that were present were not in favor of opening the section line, the County Commissioners agreed because of the cost of putting the road in would be astronomical, also a bridge would be needed and they did not feel like it would ever be completed due to the terrain, the person that requested the Section Line opening was a friend of the actual land owner wanting the Section Line opened.
